CCHS YEARBOOK SENIOR PORTRAITS



Seniors may submit their own portrait if it meets the following criteria and is approved by Mrs. Mulso:

- 1. Photos must be in the proportions of a 2" by 3" vertical portrait.
- 2. The portrait must be a **head and shoulders shot only**. If you submit a portrait that includes more than head and shoulders, we will crop it down to head and shoulders.
- 3. NO PETS, PROPS, or SUNGLASSES
- 4. The portrait may be color or black/white. Portraits will appear in color, but you still may submit a black and white photo.
- 5. <u>DIGITAL PHOTO FILES</u> are preferred. Bring the file to Mrs. Mulso on a jump drive or e-mail it to ashley.mulso@canoncityschools.org in JPEG OR TIFF format. Please make sure you receive a confirmation email to ensure that I got the photo. I will email you back to confirm
- 6. WE CANNOT ACCEPT photos you printed on your home printer or took with your cell phone. They are not up to publishing standards and will not reproduce at an acceptable quality. ALL PHOTOS MUST BE AT LEAST 500KB. To make sure your picture is large enough, right click on to file and go to properties. Make sure if you are sending by email, that your email program will not automatically re-size your pictures to a smaller file size.
- 7. The deadline for acceptance of senior portraits is the Friday before January 30, 2022.
- 8. Late submissions **ARE NOT GUARANTEED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE YEARBOOK**. It totally depends on whether or not the page on which your photo should appear has already been finalized and sent to the publisher.
- 9. Mrs. Mulso reserves the right to refuse any photo that does not meet the criteria listed above or in any way compromises the integrity and standards of the yearbook. Questions? See Mrs. Mulso in Room 102 or e-mail her at ashley.mulso@canoncityschools.org.
