Principal's Message

Happy Fall!

The Work and Friday Session programs are one of the primary methods at CCHS to help students overcome academic challenges. The program is defined in detail in the Student Handbook, which can be found online at [this link](#). To summarize, Work sessions are held by each teacher (excluding PE teachers) at least once per week for 35 minutes to help students recover from missing or poor grades. This time is individualized for each student, and access to the teacher is more significant than in the classroom. You can find the list of teacher-scheduled Work Sessions on Page 2 of this newsletter.

After a teacher holds two Work Sessions for a student who has yet to achieve a passing grade in the class, the teacher schedules a Friday Session to provide even more time (2 total hours) for the student to work toward a successful grade.

Work and Friday Sessions are not punishment but an opportunity to successfully achieve credits toward graduation. Please talk with your students if they are failing a class to see if they are taking advantage of these sessions. If a student does not take advantage of Work and Friday Sessions and is failing a class, they can be dropped from the class into a credit recovery online opportunity. Credit recovery costs \$55 per course.

On another note, mark your calendars for the SELF Expo! On December 19th, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM in the Tiger Dome, 9th-11th grade students will display their work in classes over the semester. It's an opportunity for you to participate in your child's education in a celebratory fashion. Please join us!

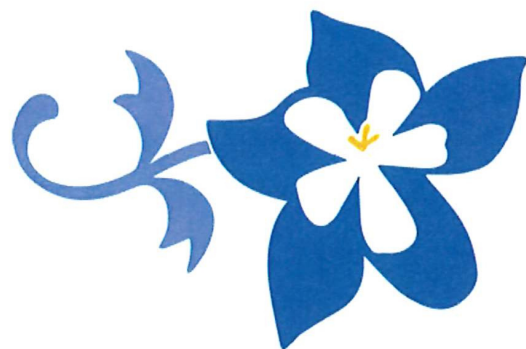


Innovation Lab
